



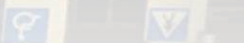

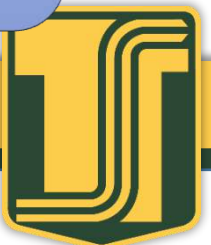

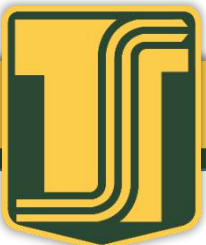

HOME-BASED LEARNING (HBL)

- 10 HBL days spread across Terms 1-4
- Dates communicated via FTs and termly circulars (on PG)
- Students to notify FTs if unable to participate in HBL. This is to facilitate attendance-taking.



SELF-INITIATED LEARNING (SIL)

- Develop **passionate learners** who would **go beyond the textbook** to explore the world and derive a **sense of fulfilment** and **deeper learning** in the process.
- SIL is time set aside for students to **learn beyond the formal curriculum** and **explore a strength or area of interest**.



HBL AND SIL: PARTNER WITH US

- Encourage and monitor your child's engagement with online tasks
- Regularly discuss your child's SIL activities and progress through the year



ASSESSMENT @ TPSS

- Assessment is vital to both teaching and learning.
- Assessments reveal your child's progress, highlight improvement areas, and inform our teaching strategies.
- School-based assessments gauge your child's understanding to support learning goal achievement.

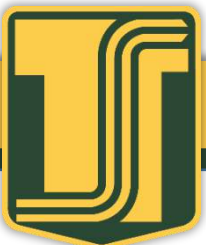

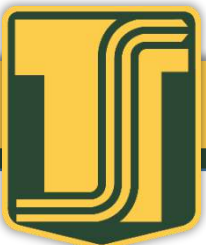

- Instil curiosity and resilience in our students
- Character and Citizenship Education will feature more prominently throughout school life
- Blended learning will be a regular feature in secondary schools and pre-university

- Schools will reduce carbon emissions
- IHLs will build on existing sustainability efforts through their curriculum, infrastructure, industry partnerships and research
- Science Centre will complement schools' sustainability education efforts, and reach out to public through programmes and exhibits

废车厂老板17岁儿发挥巧思 报废巴士座位 改装成办公椅

人弃我取!废车厂老板的17岁儿子发挥巧思,把报废双层巴士的座椅拆下改装成办公椅,放上网兜售“试水温”,却意外吸引不少网友来询问,一天内接获80张办公椅的订单!

废车厂“金利发私人有限公司”的面簿专页在周一发贴文,售卖一张由新捷运双层巴士座椅改装成办公椅的贴文,一张椅子卖100元,若是想要大量订购还可以获得折扣。

该贴文后来引起关注,网民热烈反应,不少有“巴士情结”的网民也纷纷留言表示想要订购,甚至有网民还打趣问说能否为办公椅加上扶手。

原来这张“办公椅”是由废车厂老板17岁的儿子曾俊睿改装的,他从中学开始就跟着父亲到废车厂学习拆卸巴士和罗厘零件,目前就读新加坡理工学院商业管理一年级的他,也“半工半读”帮父亲经营废车厂生意。

他受访时说,早前在网上看到别人改装巴士座椅,因此也想亲自挑战看看,父母得知后很支持,于是开始购买改装所需的零件。

由于曾俊睿特别要求是橙红色的巴士座椅,父母特意向同行朋友购入座椅后,让儿子去研究改装,父亲也提供意见该如何让椅子底部更加稳固。

曾俊睿说,在车厂员工的协助下,他花了将近两个小时才把一张座椅改装完毕,改装过程包括要把双人座椅切割成单人椅、清理坐垫、安装椅子的轮子、升降脚等。

“我把价格定在100元,放上网看看有没有人要买,没想到隔天就在网上传开,询问电话一个接一个,一天不到就被订了80张椅子,令人又惊喜!”

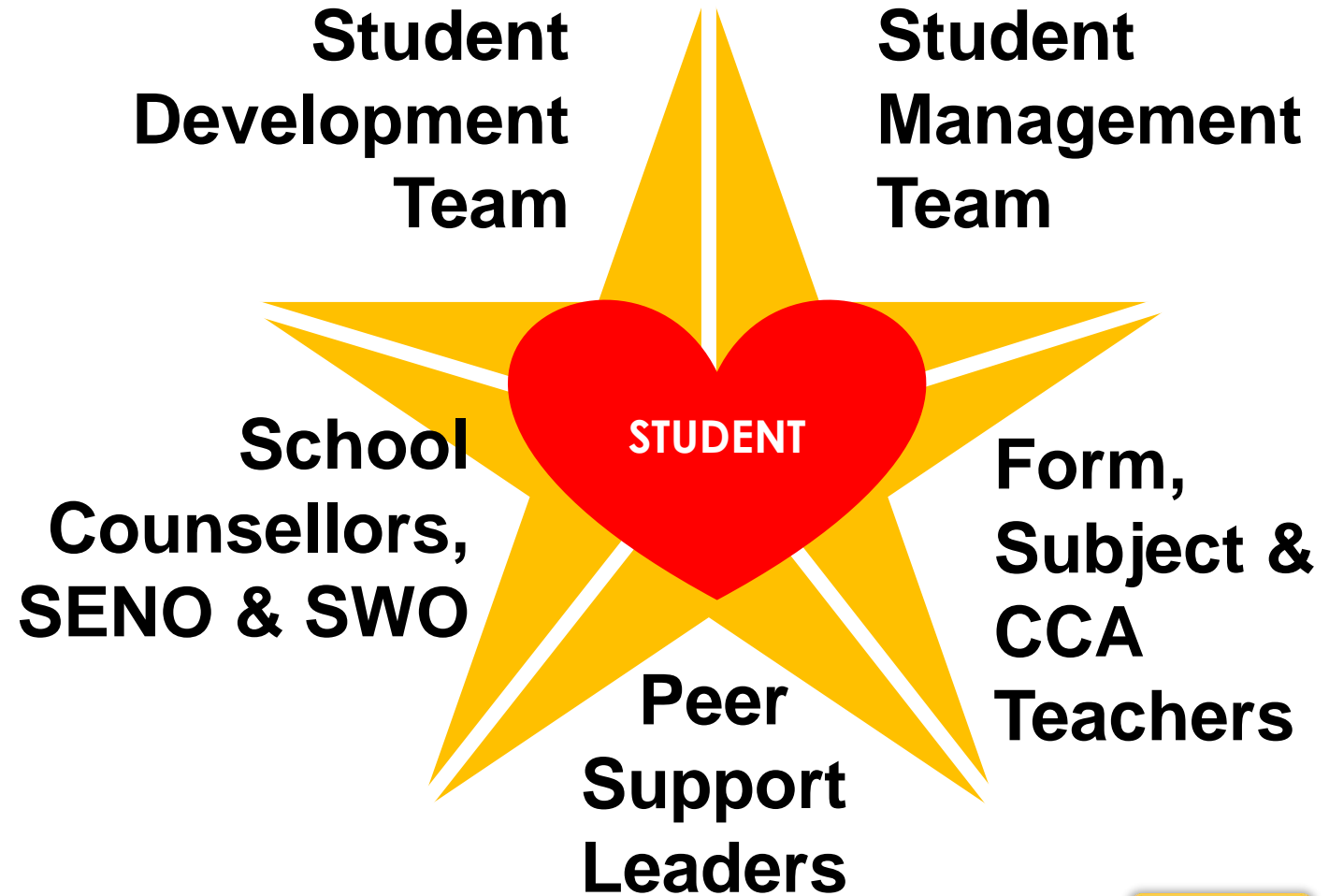

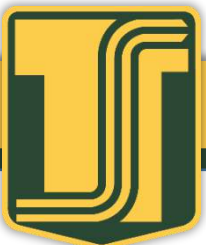

Time

Consciously set aside time for our teens. Find regular opportunities, such as common mealtimes or evening/weekend family activities.

Expectations

Recognise that while we may have expectations of them, they too have their own strengths and interests to explore and develop.

Empathy

Encourage them to share their thoughts and feelings honestly. Listen without showing judgment. They will be more willing to listen to your views when you seek to understand theirs too.

Nurture

Be a facilitator rather than a supervisor. Experiencing challenges is part of their learning process. Trust that they will be capable of discovering solutions for themselves, even if it takes a longer time.

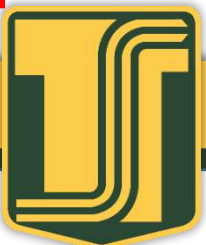

Supporting your Child

Transitioning from Primary to Secondary School

MOE offers the following tips:

1. **Help them understand the common challenges** (new everything, environment, friends, syllabus, phase of life)
2. **Support their development and interests** (help them get a sense of belonging, purpose and progress, opportunities to contribute to school, interests and new things to learn, teachers who care and can cater to their educational needs, the ability to enjoy the learning process at an appropriate level)
3. **Encourage them to prepare the transition** (encourage choosing subjects and electives that interest them, looking beyond academics and pursuing activities that excite them, making new friends and involving themselves in clubs/CCAs, talking to you if they have difficulties)



Supporting your Child

Transitioning from Primary to Secondary School

PPN parents' tips from experience:

1. **Let them explore and familiarise with their 'new everything'** (give them time and space to process on their own, otherwise we might be transferring our anxieties and preoccupations to them)
2. **Keep the door open for any kind of talk** (it helps if they know they can talk to us about pretty much everything)
3. **Show them it has been done before** (share how everywhere and every year others go through the same, and even how in our times we had to deal with the transition)
4. **Acknowledge explicitly that they have to undergo a big transition** (acknowledge the increase of subjects and workload, together with having to go through another major exam in 4/5 years time, reassure them their teachers are there to help and that the big change it's a sign they are ready for it and able to do more, means growing bigger)
